Scams to Avoid in the Summertime



Summertime is upon us, and vacations with family and friends are on the rise. Unfortunately, scammers never take a vacation, so protect yourself from summertime scams with these helpful tips:

Avoid "free" vacation scams

Travel scams pop up every year as summer approaches! You may get an unexpected letter, phone call, email or text message saying you've won an all-expense-paid luxury vacation or cruise. But if you're asked to provide sensitive information or pay a fee to claim your "prize," you're dealing with a scammer, not a trustworthy company. Remember, if something seems too good to be true, it probably is.

Book vacation rentals carefully

Booking a stay in a private home or apartment can be a convenient and budget-friendly alternative to hotels.

THE 46TH ANNUAL STATESMAN CAPITOL 10K

In Austin, TX

Greater Texas Credit Union employees were joined by friends and family on Sunday April 16th in Austin, Texas to volunteer and hand out finisher medals at the 46th Annual Statesman Capitol 10K.

Beginning in 1993 the Capitol 10K race donated from its event to local community non-profit organizations, with 20 organizations receiving funds. Including the 2022 event, the Statesman, participants, and sponsors have donated over \$3 Million to the Austin community. The 2022-2023 Race Beneficiary is the Mike & Sherry Project. It was established in 2019 with a mission to provide accessible mental health care to individuals working in the Austin restaurant, bar and hospitality industry.

However, it's important to watch for rental listings that aren't what they seem. Con artists have been known to draw victims in with fake photos, discounts and amenities. Some scammers even list properties that they don't own.

To protect yourself, only use reputable vacation rental services that verify properties and owners, and read reviews from other guests. When you're ready to reserve your stay, pay through the booking company instead of sending money to the owner directly, and make sure they have a protection policy for guests

Road tripping? Watch for Card Skimmers

If you're heading out on the road this summer, remember to use caution at unfamiliar gas stations and ATMs. Criminals can steal credit or debit card information by attaching illegal "skimmer" devices to gas pumps and ATM card readers.

Here are a few tips for spotting a skimmer:

- » Look for signs of tampering, such as broken pieces or sticky glue on any part of the machine.
- » Wiggle the card reader itself. If it feels loose, it might be a skimmer.
- » Look at the keypad. Does it appear raised?
- » Open up your phone and connect to Bluetooth, if a string of letters and numbers appears, a skimmer may be attached to a device nearby.
- » When in doubt, find another gas pump or ATM.
- » As always, monitor your account statements regularly for any charges you didn't make. Scammers will often "test" stolen card data by charging a few cents at a time, so look carefully.

Use credit cards for travel spending

Credit cards are a smart choice for travel spending because they offer greater fraud protection than debit cards and cash. If your card is accidentally lost or stolen, it will be easier to freeze your account and dispute unauthorized transactions.

If you're planning on traveling internationally, call your credit card company in advance so they know to expect activity from a different country. When you return from your trip, review your statement carefully to spot any suspicious charges.
