



This policy is set forth in order to establish:

1. Acceptable interactions on social media between members and the credit union
2. Responsibilities toward compliance, privacy and information security

Acceptable Social Media Conduct Between You and the Credit Union

1. Be at least 18 years old when interacting with Greater Texas | Aggieland Credit Union social media.
2. Be responsible for the content you share and all activity that occurs under your accounts. The credit union has no responsibility to you or any third-party for any material you share or any breach of your obligations under this policy. We strongly advise against posting personal financial details on social media, such as your credit union account number, card numbers or images, or any other private personal or financial information.
3. Do not use any of Greater Texas | Aggieland Credit Union's social media for display of personal attacks, defamation, harassment, spam, offensive content, aggressive behavior, or illegal activities.
4. Greater Texas reserves the right to restrict or remove any content deemed in violation of the collective code of conduct or any applicable law, which includes but is not limited to, deleting posts or comments that constitute as spam or harassment, advocate illegal activity, promote unrelated services/products/political organizations, infringe on copyrights or trademarks, use personally identifiable financial information, or any other content the credit union deems inappropriate for social media.
5. Greater Texas reserves the right to monitor, prohibit, restrict, block, suspend, terminate, delete, or discontinue access to any social media, at any time, without notice and at its sole discretion.
6. By sharing content on any social media, the participant grants Greater Texas | Aggieland Credit Union the irrevocable right to reproduce, distribute, publish, and display such content and the right to create derivative works from your content, edit or modify such content and use such content for any purpose.
7. The participant expressly acknowledges and assumes all responsibility related to security, privacy, and confidentiality risks inherent in sharing any content over the internet.
8. Greater Texas | Aggieland Credit Union reserves the right to prosecute, to the full extent of the law, anyone who uses social media to defame or damage the organization, its directors, or its employees.

Compliance, Privacy and Information Security Responsibilities

1. All social media conduct must comply with policies and requirements set forth by the National Credit Union Administration (NCUA) and the Federal Financial Institutions Examination Council (FFIEC).
2. Members should use caution when posting personal information on any Greater Texas | Aggieland Credit Union social media site, including but not limited to, identifiable information such as your location, account number, financial information, or other private information.
